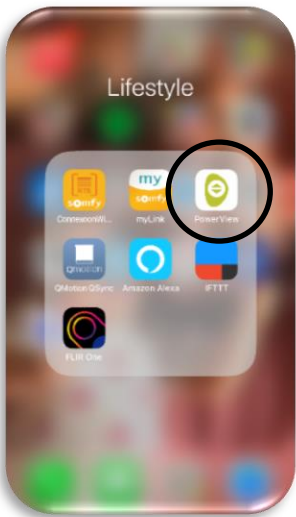
Connecting PowerView Hub with Amazon Alexa

Instructions to assist you with being able to connect Powerview Shades to Amazon Alexa.

It's important to note that you must load your shades onto the Powerview hub and setup your scene's before starting the below process.

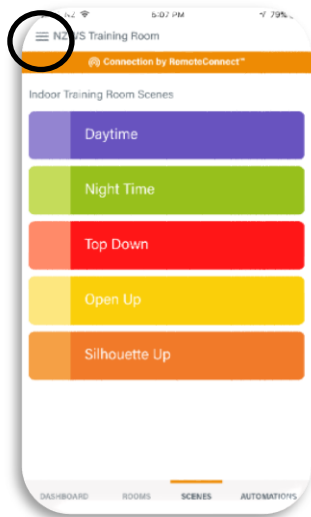
Step 1:

Open Powerview App



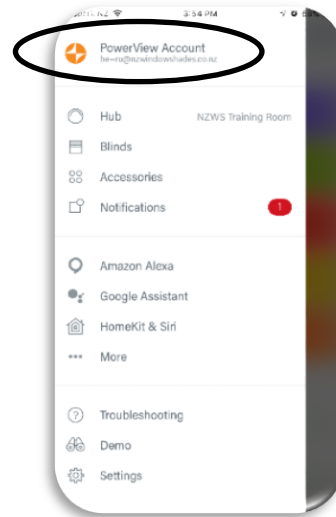
Step 2:

Its essential that the Powerview App has been registered



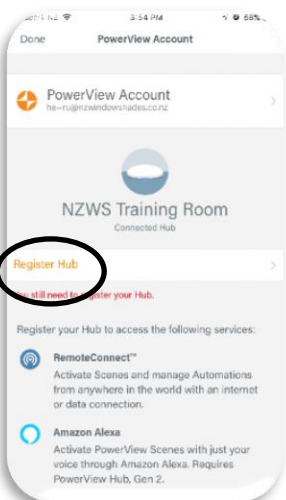
Step 3:

Open your Powerview Account



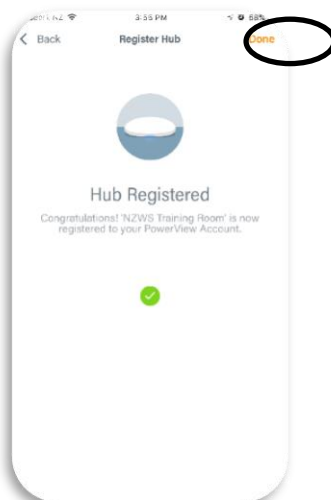
Step 4:

Click on 'Register Hub' to register your Powerview Hub



Step 5:

Once your Hub is registered, you can then continue programming with Amazon Alexa. Click 'Done' and close Powerview App



Step 6:

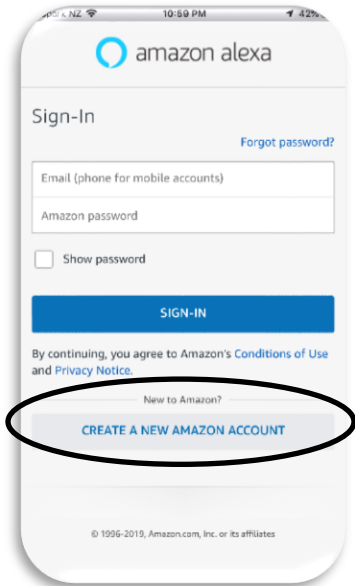
Download 'Amazon Alexa' app from the APP store (iPhone/iPad) or Google Play.



Step 7:

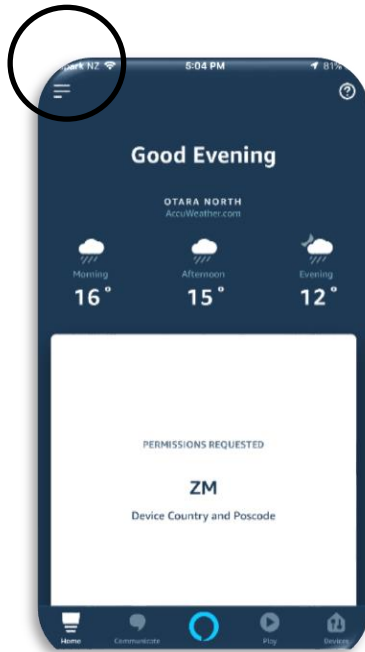
Open the app. You will need to 'Create a New Amazon Account' (if not already created)

NOTE: Its always best to use the customers own email and password.



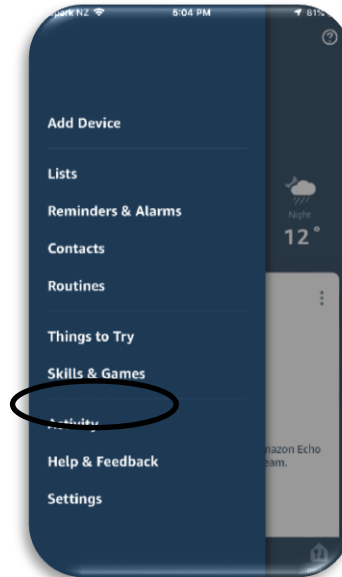
Step 8:

Click the drop down menu at the top left.



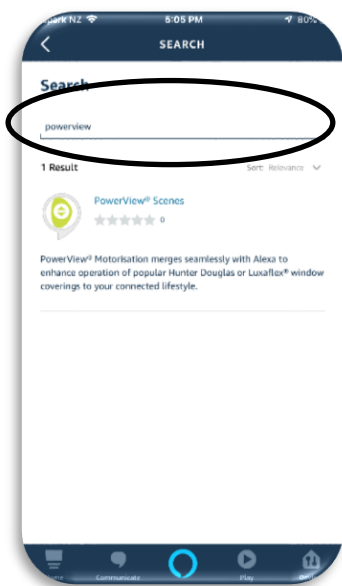
Step 9:

Click on 'Skills & Games'



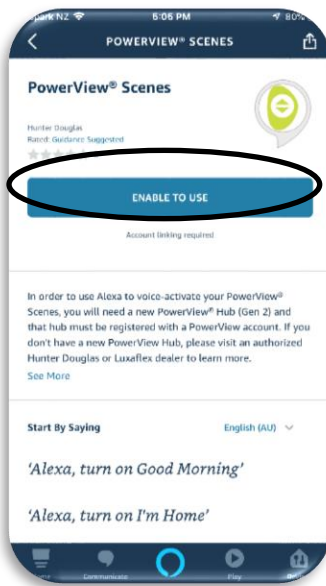
Step 10:

In the search area, search 'Powerview'



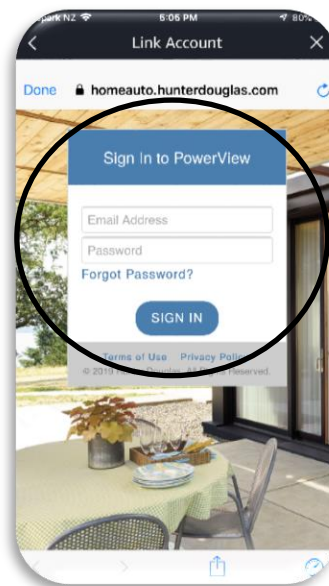
Step 11:

Click the 'Enable to Use' tab.



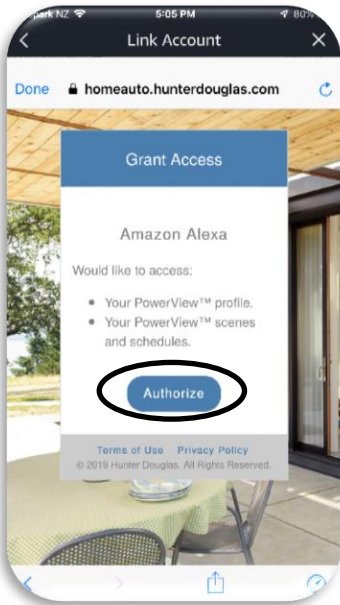
Step 12:

Sign into your PowerView account



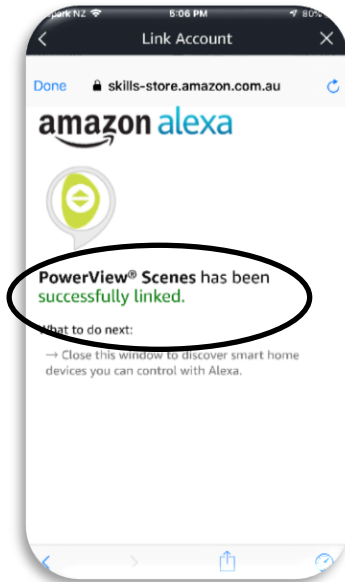
Step 13:

Click 'Authorize' to allow Amazon Alexa to connect with your Powerview account.



Step 14:

Your Powerview account has successfully been synced with Amazon Alexa



Step 15:

Click 'Discover Devices' tab.



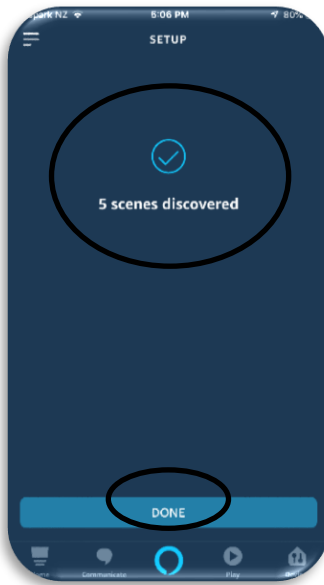
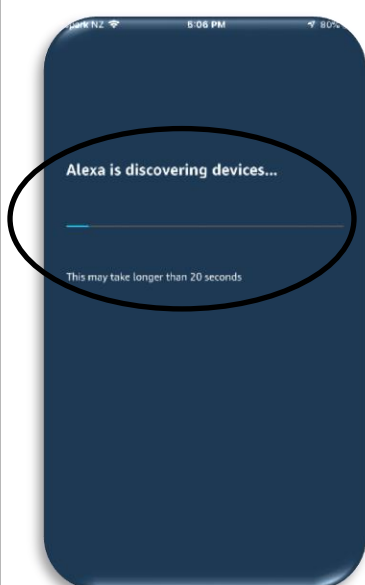
Step 16:

Amazon Alexa will begin to search for your Powerview Hub and start the discovery of your scenes.

NOTE: Do not exit the app during this time. Wait until the app confirms that it has found your scenes already created using the Powerview Hub.

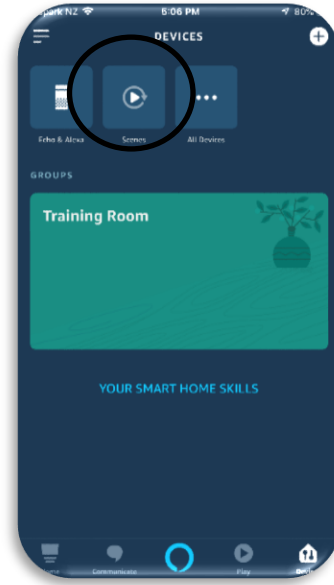
Step 17:

Once scenes discovered, click the 'Done' tab.



Step 18:

Click on 'Scenes' tab to check that all Powerview Hub scenes have been picked up by Amazon Alexa



Step 19:

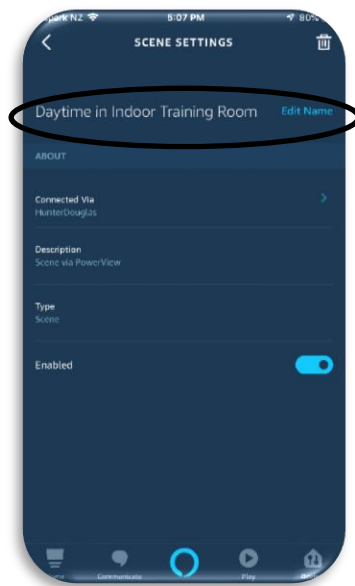
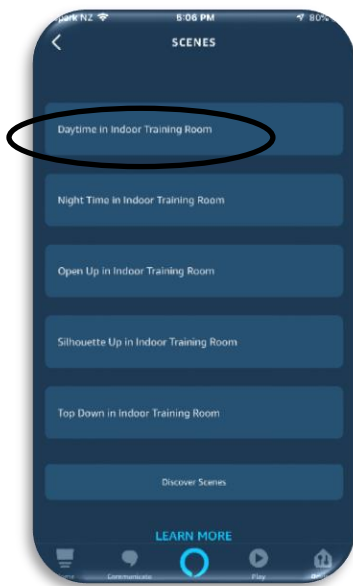
All of your scenes will be displayed as they have been saved on the Powerview Hub.

To make any changes to the names of these, first click on the scene you wish to make changes to.

Step 20:

Click 'Edit Name' to make any changes to the name of the scene which will become the command used to control using your voice.

NOTE: Its always recommended to make your commands simple words and not to overcomplicate these to ensure Alexa understands easily.



Step 21:

To control your Powerview blinds using voice control, simply speak the following:

'Alexa, Turn On' followed by the exact wording from the discovered scene.
E.G; Alexa, Turn On Good Morning

NOTE: Firstly, speak Alexa and wait for the solid blue light to appear. Once the blue light appears, complete the rest of the sentence.

TIPS

- Before attempting to discover PowerView Scenes in the Alexa App, please ensure your PowerView Hub is registered to your PowerView Account.
- After your PowerView Scenes have been discovered in the Alexa App, use the Groups menu in the Smart Home tab to combine your PowerView Scenes with other smart devices within your home. You may also use it to group together multiple PowerView Scenes, such as Shade Scenes and Repeater Scenes, for integrated voice-activated control.
- If you did not discover all of your PowerView Scenes after linking to your account, or you need to discover new Scenes in the future, you can always discover more PowerView Scenes by selecting "Discover" in the Scenes menu of the Smart Home tab in the Alexa App.
