

# Kona Folding Arm Awnings

## Quoting Best Practice

When deciding on where to fit your awning, there are a couple of things that need to be considered to ensure a successful installation. This includes checking for the following:

### Checklist

- Measure width and drop of where the awning is to be installed
- Ensure there are no obstructions that could interfere with the installation and operation of the awning. Consider things such as light fittings, doors, spouting pipes, power lines, posts etc
- Select the right model for the customers' requirements
  - **Kona Classic**
  - **Kona Design**
  - **Kona Cross-Over**
  - **Kona Rise**
  - **Kona Semi-Cassette**
- Select awning colour and fabric to be used
- Choose your operating option; either Crank Handle or Automation
  - If crank handle, select the length of handle required
  - If Awning is automated, select the motor required. You will need to ensure that you select the motor positioning ensuring there is power accessible to that side.
- Select remote control and any wind/motion sensor options (Only required if awning is automated)
- Add on any extra options that the customer may want. These options include:
  - **Roller Valance**
  - **Telescopic Arms**
  - **Pitch Control**
  - **Rain Hood**

(Ensure you check your pricing pages to ensure options are available with the model selected previously. If they are not available, you may need to change your model selection)
